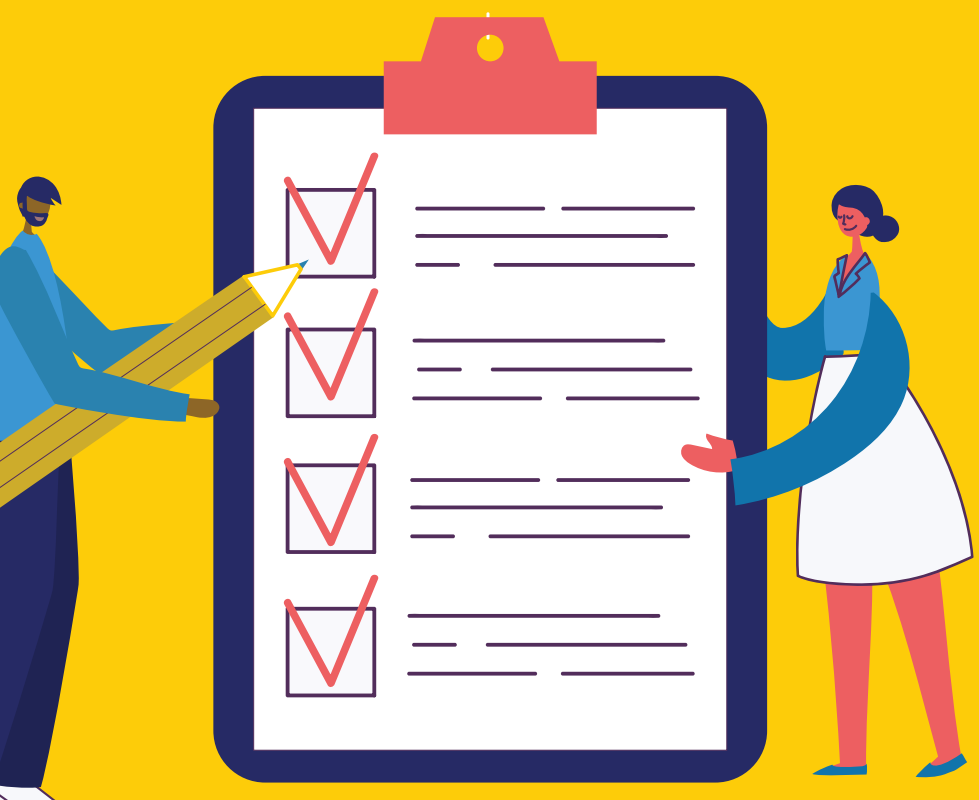


5 TIPS for Keeping Students Engaged in Virtual Classrooms



1 CLARIFY EXPECTATIONS IN ADVANCE

- **SHARE** the goal of the lesson and the expectations for participation
- **POST** resources and information for students prior to lessons
- **ESTABLISH** clear rules for behavior and virtual classroom etiquette



2 MAKE LESSONS VISUAL AND INTERACTIVE

- **INCORPORATE** infographics, streaming videos, podcasts, and other multimedia content
- **GAMIFY** your lesson with fun quizzes, point-based rewards, and game-based competitions
- **BREAK** the material into bite-size pieces to keep students' attention



3 ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO CONNECT

- **ASSIGN** small group projects
- **CREATE** virtual breakout rooms to encourage collaboration
- **SET UP** discussion boards for students to communicate with each other

4 KNOW THE TOOLS ON YOUR LIVE STREAMING CLASSROOM PLATFORM

- **USE** sharing functions such as whiteboards, annotations, content and screen sharing, and more
- **ENCOURAGE** students to use the chat function and emoticons to share feedback during class
- **USE** polls frequently to check for understanding



5 MAKE YOURSELF AVAILABLE TO YOUR STUDENTS

- **COMMUNICATE** with energy and enthusiasm
- **SCHEDULE** virtual office hours for extra help
- **CONNECT** individually through messaging or breakout rooms
